**What's large enough** to seat 750 guests for dinner while 1,200 other guests are playing golf, bowling, testing their skills on video games or driving a car on an Indy-style race track? It's The Amazing Pizza Machine and it opened to the public on April 28th. In terms of sheer size at 65,000 square feet, there is nothing comparable between Minneapolis and Denver. The array of games, rides and attractions, all under one roof, are unparalleled in the region.

When the doors opened to the public they found 140 video games, rides and attractions from glow-in-the-dark golf to racecars, all located in one climate-controlled complex. If you spent just five minutes playing every game and attraction, and riding the rides, it would take you 12 hours.

The grand opening featured a collaborative undertaking between the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation, Heartland Family Services and Camp Fire U.S.A. Midlands Council. As a result of this event, donations have been made in the amount of \$2000 to JDRF, \$700 to Camp Fire U.S.A. Midlands, and \$600 to Heartland Family Services. The Amazing Pizza Machine is owned and operated by 6 4 Fun, LLC, a Nebraska company committed to creating a fun, family-friendly entertainment venue.
